



Magical Holidays

Christmas is around the corner and the holidays are upon us. The kids need entertaining. What better way to spend time than bonding over some magical holiday activities!

What you will need:

- A balloon
- 3 spoonsful of baking soda
- Funnel
- Bottle of vinegar
- 500ml plastic bottle

Self-inflating balloon

A few simple steps and watch your child's face light up in joy and wonder as they watch the balloon inflate magically.

1. Fill the balloon with 3 spoonsful of baking soda using a funnel.
2. Fill $\frac{1}{4}$ of the plastic bottle with vinegar.
3. Fix the balloon onto the bottle lid. Be careful to not tip the baking soda into the vinegar.
4. Lastly, get your child to slowly tip the baking soda that is inside the balloon and watch the magic happen.



Magical inflating balloon!!!

What you will need:

- A plastic jar with a lid
- Dishwashing soap
- Glitter and food colouring (Optional)

Tornado in a jar!

Create a real tornado in a jar. It's a great opportunity to have a small lesson about natural disasters as well.

1. Fill the jar with water up to slightly below the brim.
2. Squirt some dishwashing soap into the jar and add in food colouring/glitter (Optional).
3. Screw the lid on tight and give the jar a hard spin. Now watch a magical tornado appear!

What you will need:

- 6 white flowers with stalks (rose, carnation, etc)
- Food colouring (red, blue, violet, orange, yellow, green)
- 6 containers
- Water

Rainbow flowers

This is a great family activity, and you can create a beautiful bouquet for your dining table too.

1. Fill the jars with water and add in food colouring.
2. Place the flowers in each container and watch it turn from a plain white flower to a beautiful magical flower. Watch the transformation over time!

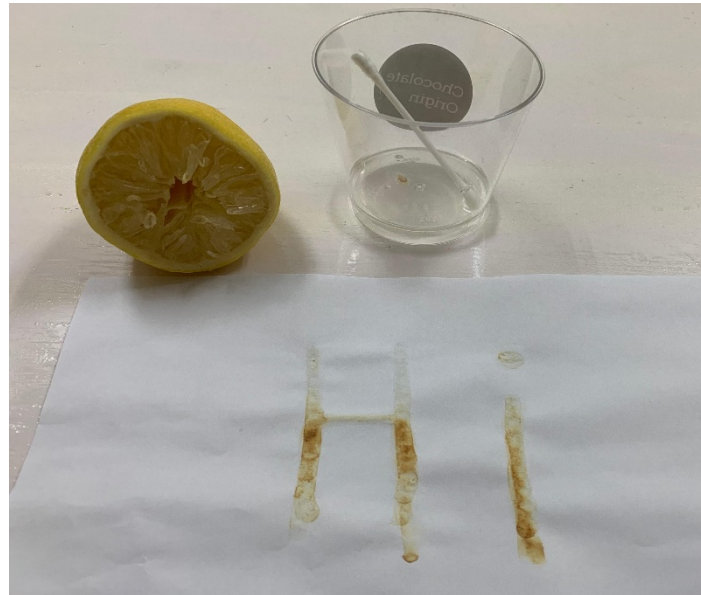
What you will need:

- Lemon juice
- Iron (adult supervision is required when handling the iron)
- Cotton buds
- A4 Paper

Magic ink

Create some secret messages and notes with this magic ink. Maybe you can even make some special greeting cards that require special reading equipment.

1. Ask your child to pick up a cotton bud and soak it in lemon juice.
2. Ask them to write a secret message on the paper with the lemon juice infused cotton bud.
3. Leave it to dry for a while.
4. Use the iron and move it across the paper to reveal the secret message. Have a magical time!
